The person who serves as the Local Homeless Liaison may also serve in the primary capacity of the principal, assistant principal, Title I Coordinator, teacher or Social Worker. Please peruse the information below for an overview of the services and the role of our Local Homeless Liaison in reference to the Title VII-B of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act:

- Local Homeless Liaison role:
  - Assist students in enrolling in school.
  - Assist students in attending school.
  - Assist students in participating in school activities.
  - Assist students in succeeding in school.
  
- Coordination Plan of Services Provided to Dove's Homeless Students:
  - Provides information about transportation and sheltering/housing resources.
  - Special Education.
  - Title 1, Part A.
  - Supports advanced and accelerated students.
  - Supports English Language Learners.
  - Vocational/Technical Education information.
  - Supports Gifted and Talented.
  - Provides School Nutritional Meals and Additional Information.
  - Provides Before/After-School Care.
  - Provides Preschool Program and additional information.
  - Provides school supplies and hygiene kits.
