Dove Academy of Detroit Dress Code

BOTTOMS

Male Scholars:

- Navy, black, or khaki solid casual/uniform dress pants or long casual / uniform shorts
- Black or brown belt (must be worn the entire day)

Female Scholars:

- Navy, black, or khaki solid casual/uniform dress pants
- Navy, black, or khaki skirts, long casual / uniform shorts, skorts, or jumpers are acceptable, as long as the bottom of the skirt is equal to or longer than her longest fingertip

NO blue jeans, denim, jeggings or leggings of any type or color including overalls or sweatpants are allowed.

TOPS

All Scholars:

- All Tops must have Dove Academy's Logo with NO colored trim or decoration
- NO personalized shirts with any type of print, writing, pictures, etc
- NO Tank tops, sleeveless t-shirts, open mesh, jersey shirts
- Dark blue button up sweaters can be worn over uniform shirts
- Plain dark blue or black hoodies (zip up or pull over) can be worn over uniform shirts.
NO HOODS CAN BE WORN AT ANY TIME INSIDE THE BUILDINGS
- Students are required to keep their shirts tucked in throughout the entire school day

(K-6th) - Collared Royal Blue polo or other Dove Academy tops that have been purchased through our vendor and/or Class College Shirts (Friday)

(7th & 8th) - Light Blue Button-Down dress shirts (ties may be worn) or other Dove Academy tops that have been purchased through our vendor and/or Class College Shirts (Friday)

Please Note: All uniform shirts, on all scholars, must be neatly tucked into the waistband at all times.

FOOTWEAR

- NO slides, sandals, thongs, or other open-toed shoes (Crocs may be worn)
- NO high heeled shoes
- NO footwear with wheels and attachments

* If snow boots are worn to school during winter months, the scholar is expected and heavily encouraged to bring a pair of uniform shoes to change into.

All students are invited to wear their Class College apparel or College colors for the University that their class selects for the school year each Friday. Students will be asked to dress in specific colors for various special events throughout the school year. Notifications will be sent home with all students when these special events occur.
